### **Balancing Pool Consumer Allocation**

For 2022, the rate at which the Balancing Pool will collect from consumers will be decreased to \$2.20 per MWh of consumption, down from the current rate of \$2.30 per MWh of consumption (the "Consumer Allocation").

Since the Consumer Allocation began in 2006, the Balancing Pool has rebated over \$1.9 billion in net payments directly to Alberta's electricity consumers.

Under provisions of the Electric Utilities Act, each year the Balancing Pool is required to forecast its revenues and expenses to determine whether any excess (or shortfall) funds will be allocated to electricity consumers. The annual amount is referred to as the Consumer Allocation and has been calculated pursuant to the requirements of the amended Balancing Pool Regulation.
